APPLYING FOR A MARRIAGE LICENSE



We help you along the way

#1: MAKE SURE YOU ARE ELIGIBLE TO GET MARRIED IN NEVADA.

Couples do not need blood tests, and there is no required waiting period between getting the marriage license and having the ceremony. The legal age is 18 for everyone (proof of age is required).

#2: APPLY FOR A MARRIAGE LICENSE IN CLARK COUNTY.

Simply show up at the Clark County Marriage License Bureau and fill out the license application. They will provide it within 20 minutes. Marriage licensing fees are \$102 (credit, debit, or cash only). Checks are not accepted.

#3: GET MARRIED!


Be sure to bring your marriage license and IDs with you to give to the officiant. Now, recite those vows, exchange rings, and kiss. You're married!

#4: GET A CERTIFIED COPY OF YOUR MARRIAGE CERTIFICATE.

After the ceremony, your officiant has 10 days to file the wedding paperwork with the Clark County Clerk.

#5: CELEBRATE!

You got married in Las Vegas, guaranteeing that everyone (including you!) will have the time of your lives. Las Vegas—in all its glory—is here to celebrate you and your special day



- **How close is the Strip from the airport?**

- It's about a 15-minute drive from the airport to the Strip.
- Taxi from airport to Strip: \$19, Bell Trans Shuttle Bus: \$15, Uber/Lyft: varies but can be scheduled in advance.

- **Which season is the busiest?**

- **Is transportation needed? If yes, is it easily accessible?**
